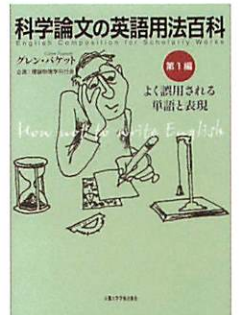

The lectures will cover the fundamentals of scientific writing. We begin with the question "What is a scientific paper?" and proceed to carry out a comprehensive treatment of the writing of scientific papers. We will discuss the most effective way of organizing a paper and constructing arguments on the basis of a scientific way of thinking. Also, we will discuss numerous points regarding the proper usage of English in scientific papers. The course is intended mainly for native Japanese speakers.
